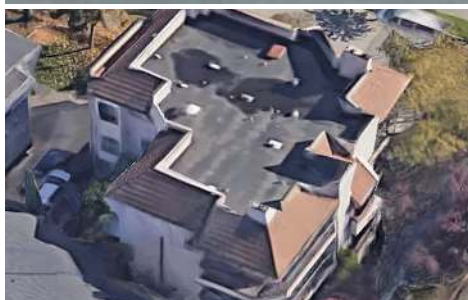

A low-rise building, with features including in-suite laundry, storage, underground parking and gas fireplaces. Fabulous West End location near Robson within walking distance to the beach, Stanley Park and Downtown. Close to everything you need, shopping, parks, hospitals and schools. A Short walk to King George International College, West End Driving School, Roberts Education Centre, King George Secondary, Lord Roberts Elementary, Pacific Gateway International College, Ashton College, Excel Career College and GEOS Language Academy Vancouver. 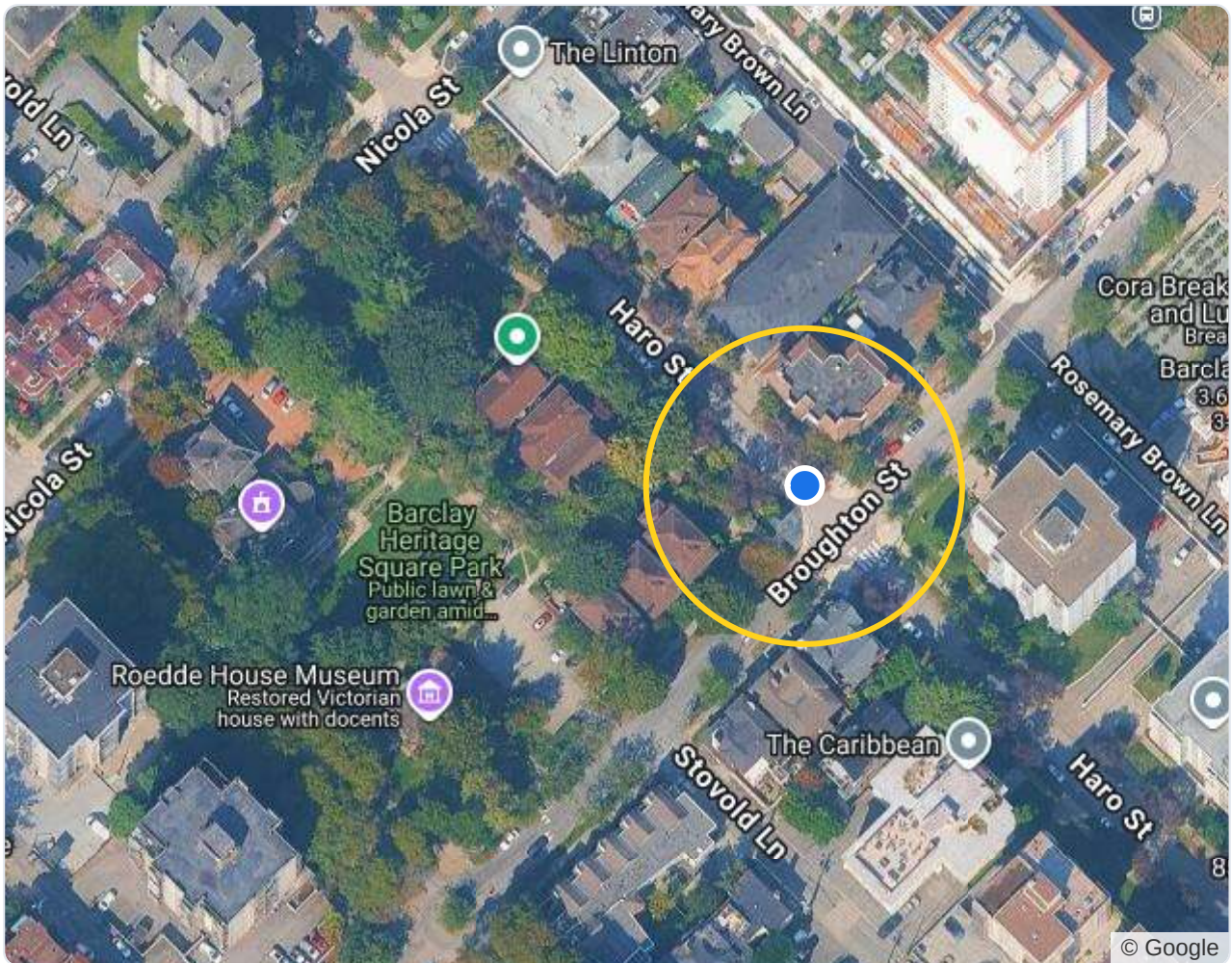
