Maintenance fees includes building insurance, garbage pickup, water and yard maintenance.

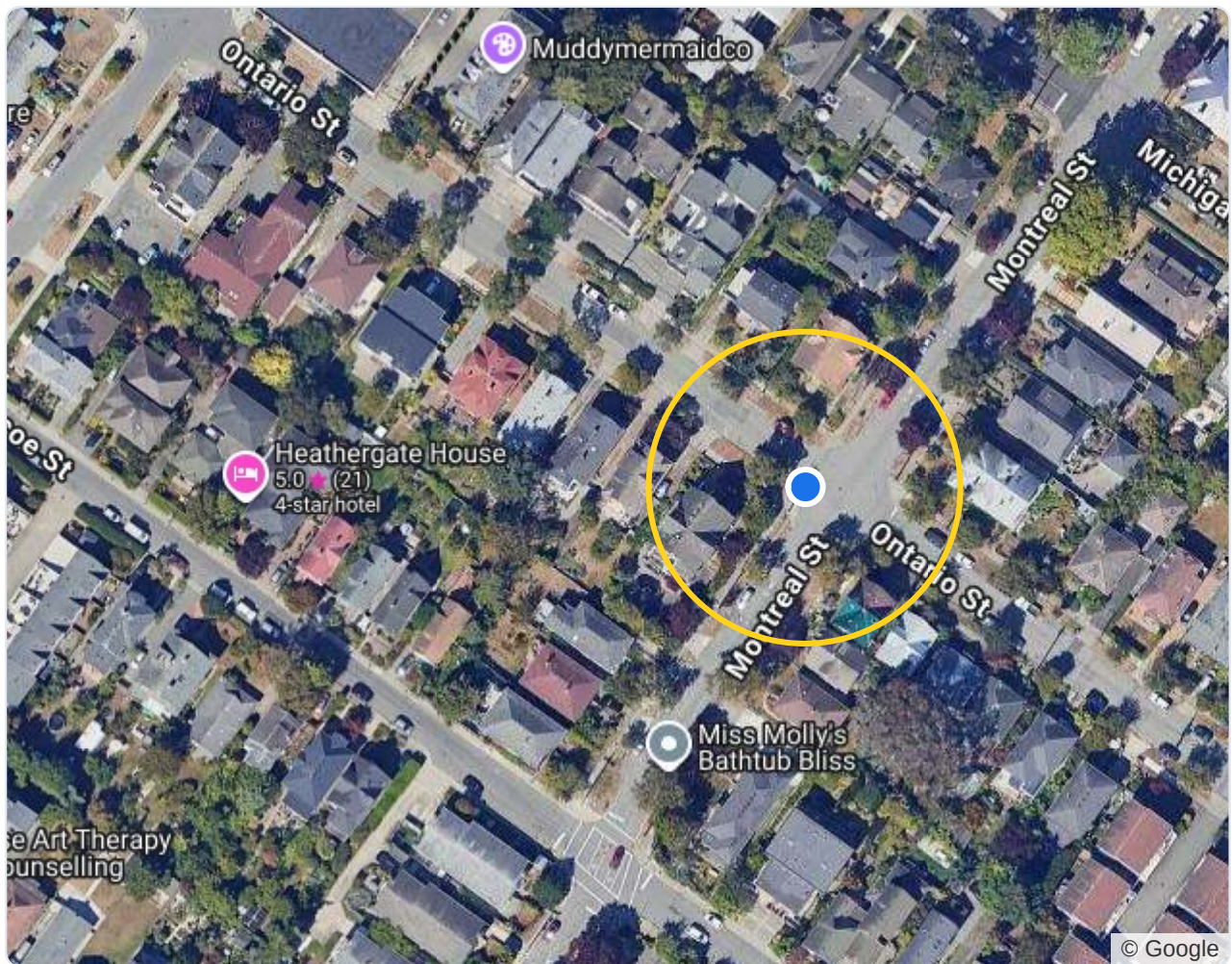
